

As of the 13th of March, Three new coronavirus (COVID-19) cases have been confirmed.

One of the cases concerns a Spanish national, a woman from Madrid. The other two are Lithuanians. A woman in Klaipėda tested positive after returning from Tenerife in the Canary Islands. A man in Kaunas has also been diagnosed following a skiing trip to Italy.

To date, 6 cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) confirmed in Lithuania.

2 cases confirmed on the 10th of March to a couple who returned from a skiing holiday in Italy (Veneto region) on the 7th of March.

The first case of the new coronavirus (COVID-19) confirmed on the 28th of February to a female patient who returned from Verona (Italy) on the 24th of February 2020.

All indoor events and outdoor events of over 100 people have been banned as of Friday. Museums, cinemas, gyms, bars and other types of public establishments have been ordered to close.

The government has announced a free coronavirus hotline, 1808, where people can report suspected coronavirus symptoms.
