

UPDATE March 23:

Nineteen new coronavirus cases were confirmed in Lithuania on Monday, bringing the country's total to 179.

A total of 2,361 coronavirus tests have been done in Lithuania so far, and one person died.

Meanwhile, 5,000 testing reagents for the coronavirus were delivered to Lithuania by a Lithuanian Air Force transport plane on Sunday night. Lithuania is awaiting some 200,000 testing kits, but the delivery was delayed to a disruption in the global supply chain.

Lithuania was placed under two-week quarantine last week to slow the spread of the virus, and the Lithuanian government is set to extend it, with the final decision expected on Wednesday.

The government plans to introduce mandatory quarantine for people returning from abroad as now such people are advised to self-isolate voluntarily.

Lithuania's police received around 2,000 reports on quarantine violations last week.
