

UPDATE March 27:

Thirteen new cases of the coronavirus were confirmed in Lithuania on Friday evening, bringing the country's total to 358. Out of the total 5,593 people tested for the coronavirus. A fifth death of the coronavirus has been confirmed Lithuania on Friday after an elderly resident of the western port of Klaipeda, who was in the risk group, died in Klaipeda University Hospital.

Lithuanian Catholic bishops have invited the faithful to celebrate the Easter season by joining in prayers to be broadcast over the Internet, radio and television. The Lithuanian Bishops Conference suspended all public services at churches after a nationwide quarantine took effect on March 1. Easter services will also have held without public participation, and certain traditional Holy Week events will not take place.
