

**UPDATE March 30:**

Lithuania has so far confirmed a total of 484 COVID-19 cases and seven deaths from the virus.

Fifty-one medical workers have tested positive and 276 are in self-isolation.

A total of 116 patients diagnosed with the novel coronavirus are currently being treated in Lithuanian hospitals and five of them are in severe condition.

A total of 11,280 coronavirus tests have been carried out in the country so far, including 1,389 on Monday.

The Municipality of Vilnius is opening two fever clinics following last Wednesday's Ministry of Health (SAM) mandate for municipalities to set up special temporary facilities to accept people with fevers and possible coronavirus infections. These clinics will commence operations next to the Lazdynai and Naujoji Vilnia polyclinics, starting tomorrow (31 March). The clinics are expected to be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. on weekdays, but could also operate on weekends depending on the amount of traffic they receive.
