Number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Lithuania: 1026

Lithuania's coronavirus death toll stands at 23, rising by six over the last 24 hours. The latest victim passed away in Kaunas.

Lithuania imposed restrictions on the movement of people on Friday night to stop people from travelling to other cities and towns and this way slow the spread of coronavirus in the country.

Around 300 posts were set up across the country, including 12 in Vilnius, but their number might change over the weekend. Under the lockdown conditions amended by the government on Wednesday, the restrictions will not apply to people going to another municipality to the funeral of a family member, in cases of a grave illness or accident, for work purposes when a person's place of work is in another municipality, also in cases where people need urgent medical assistance.

A new shipment of protective gear reached Lithuania on Saturday morning. Respirators, protective goggles, single-use clothing and facemasks will be delivered to the country's health workers.
