

**UPDATE April 20:**

Number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Lithuania: 1326

Deaths: 36

Recovered: 242

Number of tests performed yesterday: 2310

A total of samples tested in relation to the suspected coronavirus to date: 66 352

A total of 220 medical workers in Lithuania have tested positive for the coronavirus so far and 51 of them have recovered.

Over 1,000 residents of Nemencine, a town in Vilnius District, which has recently become a coronavirus hotspot, have undergone tests the coronavirus so far. Testing is still ongoing and the results will show whether the situation has been taken under control. Entry and exit restrictions were put in place in Nemencine last week in response to an outbreak of the coronavirus and will be in place until Thursday midnight.

The Lithuanian government will consider extending the nationwide coronavirus quarantine for another two weeks, while further easing the restrictions.
