Border control in Lithuania has been extended until 6 p.m. on May 14. Border control on the borders with Poland and Latvia was extended to ensure the ban for foreign to enter Lithuanian during the quarantine. Temporary border control was restored on March 14.

A ban on entering Nemencine is set to be lifted on Friday night, more than a week after the small town near Vilnius was sealed off to prevent the spread of the coronavirus.

The government decided on Wednesday to remove the restrictions, saying the town's residents had been strictly following the quarantine restrictions and the COVID-19 outbreak was largely limited to Vilnika, a local garment factory, and had been contained.
