Ninety-six percent of Lithuanian businesses that applied for wage subsidies for employees in downtime have already received the money. More than 12,000 businesses had already applied and 11,700 of them had received the subsidies, with a total of almost 10 million euros paid out.

The Lithuanian government will not regulate prices for goods and services during the coronavirus crisis, but it could take measures to increase the availability of products in case of shortages. Prices could be regulated only if a top-level state of emergency is declared.
