A total of 135 medical workers in Lithuania have tested positive for the coronavirus thus far and nearly 1,000 medics are in isolation.

Seeking to facilitate the daily lives of people in self-isolation due to the coronavirus, a mobile app Quarantine has been developed and launched. The app will benefit not only those who are obliged to stay in quarantine and isolate themselves at home, but also everyone who cares about their own health and the health of those around them.

The free updated Quarantine app, which is already available in Lithuanian and English and will be available in Russian and Polish soon, can be downloaded from the App Store and Google Play stores.

The Seimas of Lithuania on Tuesday gave nod to a pay rise of 60–100 percent for healthcare workers, including medical residents, working in coronavirus hotspots during the lockdown. Those eligible for higher wages include medical workers organizing or providing healthcare services to patients with highly dangerous communicable diseases and/or implementing preventive anti-epidemic measures in the hotspots of the disease during the lockdown.
