Number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Lithuania: 1639*

Lithuania's government will on Wednesday consider extending the lockdown until the end of June. The nationwide lockdown was imposed in Lithuania on March 16.

Lithuania's border with Latvia will be fully reopened on June 1. The decision to fully reopen the border had been made by the COVID-19 committee on Monday.

Starting from May 15, the citizens of Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia and the persons legally residing in the Baltic States do not have to justify their purpose of arrival when travelling through the territory of these countries.

Those travelling within the three countries are not checked for the symptoms of COVID-19 at border crossing points. ID checks, however, have remained in place thus far.

Four border crossing points – Butinge-Rucava, Salociai-Grenstale, Kalviai-Meitene and Smelyne-Medumi – have been opened for the citizens of the Baltic countries travelling between the three countries since May 18.
