

UPDATE June 14:

Number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Lithuania: 1768*

Deaths: 75

Recovered: 1427

Number of tests performed yesterday: 2858

A total of samples tested in relation to the suspected coronavirus to date: 363 528

*The number of confirmed infection cases. Until 28 April, information has been provided on positive laboratory test results rather than on positive cases (people).

Seven new coronavirus cases were reported on Saturday and five more on Sunday morning, bringing the total to 1,768 in Lithuania.

Four of the new infections were diagnosed in Vilnius county, while one reported in Telšiai, western Lithuania, is believed to have been contracted in Sweden.

Travelers arriving in Lithuania from Sweden, as well as Portugal, the UK and Belgium are required to self-isolate for 14 days.

At the moment, 256 of the confirmed infections are considered active cases, while 1,427 people have recovered.

So far, 75 people in Lithuania have died from Covid-19.

The Lithuanian government has decided to lift a nationwide quarantine on June 17, even though some restrictions on mass events and internal travel will remain in place.
