Hungary's Wizz Air is on Tuesday relaunching its regular service between Palanga and Dortmund, marking the first flight from the western Lithuanian airport since the country closed its borders due to the coronavirus pandemic in the second half of March.

Following a tough month in April, Lithuanian economic trends were positive in May, despite a rather gloomy mood in the services sector, Finance Minister Vilius Sapoka said on Tuesday. According to the minister, the labor market is showing some positive signs: the unemployment rate has stabilized since late April and more vacancies have been registered.

Lithuania's overall economic sentiment indicator that reflects business and consumer expectations improved by 2 percentage points in May from April, and the industrial confidence indicator rise by 7 points, Sapoka noted.
