Number of confirmed coronavirus cases in Lithuania: 1727*

*The number of confirmed infection cases. Until 28 April, information has been provided on positive laboratory test results rather than on positive cases (people).

One of the people diagnosed with the coronavirus is an employee of a supermarket in Vilnius. The person works at a Norfa supermarket on Gvazdikų Sodų 1-oji Street. The store was closed and disinfected. All the employees were instructed to self-isolate for 14 days.

Lithuania's Cabinet is on Wednesday set to decide on whether to lift the existing nationwide quarantine or extend it.

Lithuania is planning to reopen its border with Poland on Friday. There are no obstacles to relaunching free movement between the Baltic states and Poland, because their epidemiological indicators are similar and the outbreaks recorded in the neighboring country over the weekend have been localized.
